## Canned Good Collections

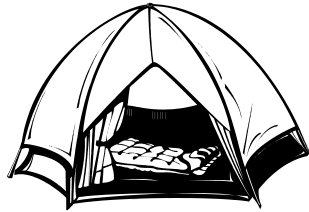
